1. Heard.
2. Keeping in view the averments made in the application, Senior Superintendent of Police, Police District Khanna, District Ludhiana, is ordered to be impleaded as respondent No. 4, subject to all just exceptions.
3. Application stands disposed of.
4. Amended memo of parties is taken on record.
5. Registry to tag the same at appropriate place.

Main case

1. By way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.PC, the petitioner seeks direction to the official respondents to take

appropriate action in case FIR (Annexure P-1) and to get the sister of the petitioner recovered. Details of the FIR are as under: -

2. Heard.
3. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is the complainant in case FIR (Annexure P-1) and after the registration of the FIR, no action has been taken by the police against the culprit and even the investigation is lying pending. She further contends that after approaching the concerned police officials time and again, the petitioner has moved a representation dated 20.12.2023 (Annexure P-3) to the Superintendent of Police, Khanna. But no action has been taken thereon.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that for the purpose of the present petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 4 to consider and dispose of the representation (Annexure P-3) in accordance with the law in an expeditious manner.
5. Notice of motion to the official respondents.
6. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harpreet Singh, Addl. AG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State-respondents and submits that representation (Annexure P-3) shall be decided expeditiously in accordance with law.

7. In the circumstances of the case and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.4-Senior Superintendent of Police, Police District Khanna, District Ludhiana, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 20.12.2023 (Annexure P-3), to dispose of the same expeditiously and to take action, as warranted, under the provisions of the law.
8. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner.
