Today at the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition at this stage. He however prays that some directions may be issued to the Investigating Officer to conclude the investigation expeditiously as on account of his weapon having been taken into possession by the police, the petitioner is even unable to apply for any job as a security personnel.

In view of the aforesaid submission, the instant petition is hereby dismissed as withdrawn.

The Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala is however directed to ensure that the matter arising out of FIR No. 74 dated 17.06.2023 under Section 336 of Indian Penal Code and Section 25, 27, 54 and 59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Dera Baba Nanak, District Gurdaspur is got investigated expeditiously, so that a final report is submitted thereafter at the earliest preferably within a period of one month from today.
