Respondent No.2- Dilbagh Singh was allowed anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. vide order dated 21.01.2022 passed by learned Sessions Judge, Karnal in case FIR No.156 dated 21.06.2021 registered under Sections 120-B, 420, 423, 467, 468, 471 & 506 of the IPC registered at Police Station Nighdu, District Karnal.

Petitioner is the complainant of the FIR and filed the present petition under Section 439 (2) Cr.P.C. for cancellation of the bail.

It is conceded by learned State counsel that after completion of investigation challan has already been filed, though charges are yet to be framed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner could not convince this Court regarding any of the grounds seeking cancellation of the bail.

Dismissed.
