As agreed, as per statement of the representatives of the Insurance Company and counsel for the appellants, (separately recorded today), a sum of Rs.3,70,000/- (Rupees Three Lakh Seventy Thousand only) more, over and above, the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants, in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount would be paid to appellant No.1-Umarawati.

Learned counsel for the appellants has given a statement before this Forum that after the death of Smt. Ram Bai-appellant No.2, the amount awarded by the learned MACT of Rs.1,00,000/-, is still pending with it and vide order dated 13.08.2021 passed by this Hon'ble High Court her LRs was ordered to be brought on record. It is further stated as per the instructions from my clients that the amount/share of Smt. Ram Bai-appellant No.2 pending with the learned MACT be also disbursed to her LRS, namely, Parveen Kumar and Sahil in equal share.

We dispose of this case with a direction to Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque in the sum of Rs.3,70,000/- (Rupees Three Lakh Seventy Thousand only) in the name of appellant No.1-Umarawati with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 21.03.2024 failing which the amount will carry 9% interest p.a. from the date of this order till the cheque is deposited with the office of the Lok Adalat. The appellant's counsel/appellant may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

The share of the deceased Smt. Ram Bai-appellant No.2 of Rs.1,00,000/- as per the award is stated to be pending with learned MACT, be also disbursed to her grand children, namely, Parveen Kumar and Sahil in equal share, as stated by learned counsel for the appellant as per instructions from his clients.

Copy of this order be also sent to the concerned MACT for necessary compliance.

Copy of the order/statement be supplied /sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
