RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Article 215 of the Constitution of India, read with Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 16.10.2023 passed in CWP-23320-2023.
2. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 16.10.2023 passed in CWP-23320-2023 has since been complied with and legal notice of the petitioner has been decided by passing the speaking order dated 26.04.2024. Copy of the order dated 26.04.2024 produced by the counsel for the respondent in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioners is left unredressed, they would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
