1. Status report by way of affidavit of Dinesh Yadav, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Palwal, District Palwal on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3-State has been filed. The same is taken on record. The status of the investigation has been spelled out in the status report as under:-

- “xx xx
2. That after registration of the FIR, the investigation of the case was carried out by SI Omparkash and he recorded statements of the witnesses.
3. That on 15.12.2023, the original agreement in dispute was taken on record after being produced by the counsel of the accused Baljeet Singh and the same was taken on record as evidence.
4. That on 18.12.2023, the specimen signatures of Bhudutt (father of the complainant) were obtained after obtaining necessary permission from the Area Magistrate, Palwal.

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5. That on 8.1.2024, KYC documents of Bhudutt were obtained from State Bank of India for matching of his specimen signature.

6. That on 18.1.2024, the specimen signature, the original agreement and KYC documents were sent to RFSL Bhondsi for their matching and reporting on the same. However, the same were returned with the objection that admitted signature of Bhudutt for the period from 2017 to 2020 be also sent.

Therefore, in order to remove the objection raised by RFSL Bhondsi Gurugram, a notice under section 91 of Cr.P.C was attempted to be served upon Bhudutt requiring him to provide the requisite documents, instead he had refused to accept the notice. Therefore, on 25.1.2024, a notice under section 91 of Cr.P.C was served upon the Manager of SBI Palwal to provide signed withdrawal forms of Bhudutt. On 1.2.2024, original withdrawal forms of Bhudutt were received from SBI Palwal and the same were taken into police possession.

7. That on 5.2.2024, the original agreement in dispute, specimen signatures, KYC documents and original withdrawal forms were sent to RFSL Bhondsi, Gurugram for their examination and report. However now report has yet been received.

8. That it is further submitted that no concrete incriminating evidence has appeared on the record yet. FSL report is still awaited on disputed and admitted signatures of Bhudutt. The further investigation in the case would be carried out after receiving the report from RFSL Bhondsi on signatures of Bhudut.”

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2. In view of above, this Court is satisfied that the authorities are proceeding in fair manner and no further order is required to be passed at this stage.
3. Resultantly, the present petition is disposed off.
