At the asking of the Court, Mr. Charanpreet Singh, AAG Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and on instructions from Sukhvir Singh, Sr. Assistant, O/o Civil Surgeon, SAS Nagar, who is present in Court, submits that the salary in question shall be released to the petitioner within a period of 2 weeks.
