This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondent for violating the order dated 22.08.2023 passed by this Court in CWP-11403-2023.

Status report by way of affidavit of respondent No.1 has been filed by learned counsel for the respondent today in the Court. The same is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan the same and place it appropriate place.

Learned counsel for the respondent has submitted that the respondent has already made the recommendation for grant of benefits to the petitioners and further action will be taken by the government. However, there is no other person, who is party in the contempt petition.

In view of the above, this Court does not find any ground to continue with the present petition any further.

Dismissed.

addressed, they would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
