1. The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for quashing of FIR No.0850 dated 29.12.2019, under Sections 306, 420, 506, 511 of IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Suraj Kund, Faridabad, District Faridabad (Annexure P-1).
2. Status report filed by way of an affidavit of Abhimanyu Goyat, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Badhkal, District Faridabad is taken on record. Registry is directed to affix the same at the appropriate place.
3. Learned State counsel has drawn attention of this Court to paras 7 & 8 of the status report, which reads as under:-

“That it is also pertinent to mention here that now the complainant and petitioners have entered into a compromise on 30.12.2022 and complainant has also produced certified copy of compromise deed and Affidavit dated 30.12.2022. Copy of compromise deed dated 30.12.2022 is being annexed as Annexure R-5. The complainant has

cleared the dues of builder. In respect of above said flat, IDBI Bank has filed a recovery case against the complainant before DRT, Delhi and after clearance of said loan, the complainant will get NOC from bank and thereafter builder will be entitled to give possession of said flat to the complainant.

That as per Investigation carried out till date, no truthfulness has been found in the Allegations levelled by the complainant. Hence a Cancellation report in the present case has been written on 31.12.2022 and information to this effect was also given to complainant on 31.12.2022 itself, which has been duly signed by the complainant. Said Cancellation report will be submitted before Ld. Illaqua Magistrate, Faridabad after approval thereof.”

4. In the light of above, this petition does not survive any further, as the same is rendered infructuous.
5. Hence, the present petition stands disposed off, having been rendered infructuous.
