1. By way of present petition filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, prayer has been made for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.108 dated 11.12.2022, under Sections 406 and 420 IPC, at Police Station Nurmehal, District Jalandhar(Rural).
2. Vide order dated 12.07.2023 passed by this Court, the matter was referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

In pursuance of aforesaid order, parties appeared before the aforesaid forum and a settlement has been arrived at between the parties, as per which a sum of Rs.2 lakh remained payable by the petitioner to the complainant.
3. Today, learned counsel for the petitioner has produced two

cheques bearing No.481481 dated 02.02.2024 and 481483 dated 10.03.2024, total amounting to Rs.2 lakhs (Rs.1 lakh each) and the same are handed over to learned counsel for the complainant in Court today. Photocopies of the cheques are taken on record.

4. To this effect, learned counsel for the complainant submits that he has no objection in case interim protection granted to the petitioner by this Court vide order dated 20.02.2023, is made absolute.

5. Having considered the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the petition is allowed. Order dated 20.02.2023 passed by this Court, is hereby made absolute.
