S.S. SARON, J.

The appeal of Resham Singh as regards his conviction for the offence under Section 302 IPC is dismissed. However, the sentence of death is modified to that of sentence of imprisonment for life, besides, he shall pay a fine of Rs.25,000/- and in default thereof, to undergo rigorous imprisonment for two years. The period of imprisonment undergone by the appellant Resham Singh during investigations, trial and pendency of the appeal shall be set off against the substantive sentences of imprisonment.

The appeal of Kulbir Sharma is allowed by giving him benefit of doubt. His conviction and sentence is set aside and he shall be set at liberty forthwith, if not wanted in any other case.
