The present petition has been filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents for willful and intentional disobedience of interim order dated 18.08.2023 passed by this Court in CWP 17821-2023.

Learned counsel for the respondents has filed a reply by way of affidavit of Vinay Baranwal, SE/HR, UHBVN, Panchkula, to contend that order dated 18.08.2023 qua which the contempt is asserted; has been complied. Copy whereof has also been supplied to counsel opposite in the Court today itself.

Registry is directed to tag the copy of the reply, filed in Court today by counsel for the respondents with the file after scanning the same, at an appropriate place.

Counsel for the petitioner has not disputed the factual position.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed as such.

However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, in accordance with law.
