1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to official respondents No. 2 and 3 not to conduct the second enquiry by respondent No. 4 in FIR No. 13 dated 15.07.2019 (Annexure P-1) registered under Section 406 of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Women Cell, Ludhiana.

2. Learned State counsel, at the very outset, submits that nothing survives in the present petition. The prayer made in the present petition is for conducting the investigation in the FIR(supra) in a fair and transparent manner. The Investigating Agency has already concluded the investigation and submitted the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. on 17.11.2020.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in spite of the fact that bail application of the accused-respondent No. 6 (Harpreet Singh) was

declined by this Court on 15.09.2022, he has not been arrested till date.



Learned counsel for private respondents submits that private respondents are pursuing their remedy as available to them in accordance with law for obtaining the anticipatory bail

4. Be that as it may, the primary grievance raised by the petitioner in the present petition has been substantially redressed and Investigating Agency has already concluded the investigation and submitted the final report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. before the jurisdictional Magistrate.

5. In view of the above, no further directions are required to be issued in the present petition and the same is hereby disposed of accordingly.

6. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to avail his alternative remedy in accordance with law.

7. Pending CRM(s), if any, are also disposed of accordingly.
