1. The present Civil Revision Petition has been filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 14.12.2022 (Annexure P-11) passed by the Executing Court/Civil Judge (Jr. Divn.), Dabwali in Execution Petition bearing No.Exe-98 of 2018 whereby the Executing Court has dismissed the application under Section 28 of the Specific Relief Act, 1963.
