The instant appeal has been preferred by the appellant-wife (Sunita Singh) against impugned judgment and decree dated 06.09.2023 passed by the learned Principal Judge, Family Court, Gurugram, whereby the petition jointly filed by her and respondent-husband (Dinesh Singh) under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (for short 'the 1955 Act') was allowed.
