NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioner from the due date and to give all the due benefits including the arrears.
2. Learned counsel for the respondent-University, on instructions, submits that the services of the petitioner has already been regularized w.e.f. 27.01.2000 and she has also been promoted as Superintendent on 09.03.2019. The fact of regularization has also been admitted by the petitioner in her additional affidavit dated 07.10.2017. He further submits that in view of the above, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous.
3. On the other hand, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is entitled to be regularized from the earlier

date as she has passed the departmental examination in the year 1995/1996. He submits that for claiming regularization from the earlier date, the petitioner shall submit a representation within a period of 04 weeks from today and the respondent-University may be directed to consider the same in a time bound manner.

- 4. Learned counsel for the respondents has no objection to the innocuous prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner.
- 5. If any such representation is filed by the petitioner within a period of 04 weeks from today, the same shall be considered and disposed of by the respondent-University by passing a speaking order within a period of 03 months thereafter.
- 6. Disposed of in the above terms.
- 7. Pending applications, if any, shall stand disposed of accordingly.
