Present third petition has been filed under Section 439 of Cr. P.C. for grant of bail pending trial to petitioner in FIR No. 82 dated 18.03.2021, under Section 302 read with Section 34 of Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station, Punhana, District Nuh.
