1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C with a prayer to grant the concession of interim bail to him to attend the marriage of his son and his niece, which are scheduled to be solemnized on 09.02.2024 and 07.02.2024, respectively.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the marriage of Harmanjit Kaur, niece of the petitioner is scheduled to be solemnized on 07.02.2024 and has relied upon card of the marriage Annexure P-3 in this regard. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner is only adult male member of the family, as his younger brother namely Gurdeep Singh had fractured on his pelvis and his still confined to bed. Learned counsel further contends that marriage of son of the petitioner is also fixed for 09.02.2024.

3. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Satwant Singh

submits that the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner have been found to be correct, during verification by the local police. He submits that the both the marriages are scheduled to be held on 07.02.2024 and 09.02.2024, as submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail at 10:00 AM on 05.02.2024 subject to his furnishing necessary surety bonds/bail bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate/CJM. The concerned Court may insist on two heavy local sureties in the present case.

5. The petitioner is directed to surrender at 10: 00 AM on 12.02.2024 at the jail gate.

7. Petition stands disposed off.
