1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 20.09.2018 passed in CWP-24163-2018.

2. Perusal of the order dated 20.09.2018 passed in CWP-24163-2018, shows that the said order was passed to protect the petitioner till regular appointments are made and was further made subject to his consideration under the policy dated 13.07.2018. However, the said policy does not exist any more. A fresh policy, though having no legal basis, has again been issued by the State of Haryana. The said new policy protects continuation of already working extension lecturers only in case they are eligible and fulfil the qualification under the relevant rules, as applicable to the posts of lecturer of College Cadre.

3. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the fact that the petitioner does not fulfil the prescribed qualification(s) as on today.

4. In view of the above, this Court does not find any violation of the order dated 20.09.2018 passed in CWP-24163-2018 in the action of the respondents, if they have replaced the petitioner with some eligible candidate, as per the policy. Accordingly, this Court does not find any ground to continue with the present petition any more.
5. Dismissed.
