1. Through the instant petition, a prayer is made for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case, FIR No.139, dated 25.11.2023, under Section 21 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Mauli Jagran, U.T., Chandigarh.
2. In para No.13 of the instant petition, the petitioner has specifically mentioned that he is not involved in any other case, or FIR under NDPS Act.
3. Today, learned State counsel has caused an appearance, and placed on record the custody certificate of the petitioner, which is taken on record. As per the custody certificate, the petitioner is facing trial in 11 cases, and convicted in 06 cases and investigation pending in two more cases, therefore, the petitioner is involved in total 19 cases. The petitioner has concealed this fact while filing the present petition.
4. In view of the above, this Court is not inclined to grant the relief of regular bail to the petitioner. The instant petition is ordered to be dismissed.
