1. The instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of certiorari, quashing the charge sheet dated 09.10.2002 (Annexure P-4) and order dated 18.02.2003 (Annexure P-6) passed by respondent No.2, ordering fresh enquiry into the charge-sheets.

2. Mr. Rimple Saini, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner and filed Power of attorney, which is taken on record.

3. On 18.11.2023, a Division Bench of this Court has restrained the respondents from passing the final orders till the next date of hearing and thereafter, the petition was admitted on 12.10.2004 and the interim order was ordered to be continued.

4. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that during the pendency of the present petition, the impugned charge sheet dated 09.10.2002 has been

withdrawn and the petitioner was also further promoted to the post of Assistant
