1. This is a contempt petition filed under Article 215 of the Constitution of India read with Sections 10 and 11 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 27.03.2023 passed in CWP-27164-2017.
2. Counsel for the respondent has pointed out that the order passed by the Writ Court has since been stayed by the Division Bench of this Court in LPA Nos.1371 and 1424 of 2023, vide order dated 27.02.2024.
3. In view of the above, the present petition does not survive any more.
4. Dismissed.
5. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to file a fresh petition, in case the above-said order dated 27.02.2024 is ever vacated or the decision in the aforesaid LPA goes in his favour.
