Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that through the impugned order the interim stay on the transfer of respondent No.1 granted by the Central Administrative Tribunal, Chandigarh Bench, Chandigarh (for short, the Tribunal) breaks the chain of 26 transfers sought to be effected by the petitioners all over the country and is causing a huge administrative difficulty but since the impugned directions are only through an interim order, he, at this stage, does not press the present petition and would be satisfied if in the light of the afore peculiar facts the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Tribunal to finally dispose of respondent No.1's Original Application in a time bound manner.

2. After considering the afore peculiar facts and because every litigant has a right to a speedy disposal of the *lis* initiated by him-her/pending against him/her as also for the reason that a direction to adjudicate upon a *lis* expeditiously prejudices none, we accept the prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioners and dispose of the present petition with a request to the Tribunal to take up respondent No.1's and other similar original applications filed and pending before it on priority and in any case, dispose of the same preferably within six months.
