1. Present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari/mandamus directing the respondents No. 1 to 3 to promote the petitioner as Assistant Sub Inspector of police with effect from 02.09.1992.
2. Learned State counsel has submitted that the matter is of the year 1995 and in all probability, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.
3. None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to rebut the said aspect inspite of the report of the registry that the counsel for the petitioner has been informed.
