The prayer in the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents No.1 to 3 to provide adequate security and protection to the life and liberty of the petitioners, who apprehend threat to their life from respondents No. 5 to 10.

Reply by way of affidavit dated 28.05.2024 of Shri Jaspreet Singh, IPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Phagwara, Kapurthala filed today in the Court and the same is taken on record.

The counsel for the State, on instructions, submits that the respondents No.5, 6 and 9 were arrested and have since been granted the concession of bail in FIR No57 dated 16.03.2024 under Sections 323/324 IPC registered at Police Station City Kapurthala. He further states that ther respondent No.10 has passed away.

As the grievances of the petitioners have been redressed, the present petition is liable to be dismissed.

In view of the contentions raised, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to approach the Investigating Agency if and when they apprehend a threat to their lives.
