RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 07.12.2023 passed in CWP-27523-2023.
2. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 07.12.2023 passed in CWP-27523-2023 has since been complied with and speaking order dated 02.01.2024 has been passed. Copy of the order dated 02.01.2024 produced by the counsel for the respondents in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law, if it feels aggrieved of the order dated 02.01.2024 passed by the respondent/concerned authority.
