The appellant seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.30 dated 14.06.2023 registered under Sections 323, 341, 34 IPC and Section 3 of SC and ST (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 (Amendment 2015), P.S. Cheema, District Sangrur.

The learned counsel for the appellant submits that in compliance of the order dated 02.02.2024, the appellant has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the appellant is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 02.02.2024 is made absolute. However, the appellant shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
