The jurisdiction of this Court under Section 438 Cr.P.C., has been invoked seeking anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 64, Under Sections 21 of NDPS Act, 1985 (Section 29 of NDPS Act added later on), dated 04.09.2023 registered at Police Station Singh Bhagwantpur, District Rupnagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 30.01.2024, the petitioner has joined investigation. This very fact is not controverted by learned State counsel who, on instructions, submits that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation as nothing is to be recovered from him.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 30.01.2024 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join investigation as and when required to do so and shall abide by the terms and conditions, as laid down under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
