In the present writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the innocuous prayer has been made for directing the respondents to allow the petitioner-firm to rectify the errors committed at the time of filing of forms and submitting GST Returns for the months of October, 2021 till February, 2022 (Annexure P-1).

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. Sourabh Goel, Sr. Standing Counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondent Nos.1 to 3.

4. Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that he would be satisfied if the competent authority takes into consideration the representation dated 27.10.2023 (Annexure P-3) and decides the same in a fixed time frame.

5. Keeping in view the limited relief and since the decision making is still incomplete, we do not propose to call upon the respondents for filing reply, as it would only delay the decision making.

6. Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed. Respondent No.3 shall redress the issue, which has been raised in the representation dated

27.10.2023 (Annexure P-3). In case any benefits are to accrue to petitioner

No.1 or its representatives, the needful will be done within a period of four weeks. In case there is any legal impediment, speaking order will be passed and supplied to the petitioner.

7. With the aforesaid observations, the present writ petition stands disposed of.
