RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 22.11.2023 passed in CWP-7652-2023.
2. Short reply by way of affidavit of Krishan Kumar, APO, Regional Passport Office, Jalandhar, filed in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 22.11.2023 passed in CWP-7652-2023 has since been complied with and necessary speaking order dated 14.03.2024 (Annexure R-1) has been passed.
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, she would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
