NAMIT KUMAR, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner has approached this Court by way of filing the instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* in terms of order dated 12.12.2001 (Annexure P-1) directing the respondents to convert his services as work charged employee alleging that he fulfils the eligibility criteria being a work charged employee.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, confines his prayer for deciding legal notice dated 20.07.2020 (Annexure P-2). He submits that at this stage, petitioner would be satisfied, if the said legal notice is decided by passing a speaking order within a time bound frame.
3. Mr. Alok Mittal, Advocate for the respondents, has no objection to the innocuous prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner.
4. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record of the case.

5. Without going into the merits of the case at this stage, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to decide legal notice dated 20.07.2020 (Annexure P-2), expeditiously submitted by the petitioner by passing a speaking order, preferably within a period of 03 months from receipt of certified copy of this order.
