NAMIT KUMAR, J.

1. Instant writ petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for directing respondent No.2 to decide the statutory appeal dated 27.10.2022 (Annexure P-7) against order dated 22.02.2022 (Annexure P-4) passed by respondent No.1 whereby period of suspension of the petitioner from 12.09.2014 to 10.07.2017 was treated as non-duty period instead of treating the same as period spent on duty for all intents and purposes.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for deciding the appeal dated 27.10.2022 (Annexure P-7) filed by the petitioner expeditiously by passing a speaking order in a time-bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Anil Kumar, Advocate, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that he has no

objection if the time-bound directions are issued to the Appellate Authority to consider and decide the appeal filed by the petitioner.

5. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the case file.

Respondent No.2-Appellate Authority is directed to decide the appeal dated 27.10.2022 (Annexure P-7) filed by the petitioner, in accordance with law by passing a speaking order as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
