The instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.232, dated 24.11.2022, under Sections 420, 406, 409, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Bichhor, District Nuh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner very fairly concedes that having interim protection in favour of the petitioner, he could not join the investigation due to certain circumstances beyond his control as he is also involved in other FIR, wherein anticipatory bail petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. was dismissed as withdrawn by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide CRM-M-32725-2023, dated 17.07.2023 and, therefore, in that eventuality having fear of arrest, he opted not to join the investigation in the instant FIR as well.

In the light of above, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition at this stage with liberty to approach on the same cause of action after getting the protection, if so, granted in other FIR.

Prayer is accepted.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
