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**HARPREET SINGH BRAR J. (ORAL)**

1. Prayer in the instant petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR bearing No.123 dated 16.12.2019 registered under Sections 406, 498-A of IPC at Police Station Women Cell, Jalandhar (Annexure P-1) and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

2. A perusal of the order sheets reveals that vide order dated 24.05.2023, the parties were directed to appear in the Court on 29.05.2023. On 29.05.2023, both the parties were present in Court. This Court made an attempt to get the matter compromised to make them stay together, however, the petitioner and respondent No.2 were not ready to stay together and the matter was adjourned. Thereafter, respondent No.2 filed an application bearing CRM No.44224 of 2022 seeking dismissal of the present petition as the compromise between the parties is not in existence.

3. Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn.
