1. By way of present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., prayer has been made for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.3 to 6 to register an FIR against respondent Nos.7 to 9 and their accomplices for extending threats to the petitioner.
2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case direction is issued to the respondents to decide the representation dated 05.01.2024 (Annexure P-2) moved at the instance of petitioner by passing a speaking order expeditiously.
3. Prayer seems to be justified.
4. Upon advance notice, Mr. Shubham Kaushik, AAG, Punjab appears on behalf of respondent Nos.1, 3, & 5 and raises no objection to the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.
5. In view of the aforesaid, but without going into the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3

i.e. The Director General of Police, Punjab to look into the representation dated 05.01.2024 (Annexure P-2) and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of 08 (eight) weeks’ from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
