By way of present petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in a case arising out of FIR No.91 dated 20.07.2023, under Sections 379-B, 411 and 34 of IPC, registered at Police Station GRP, District Amritsar.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner is in custody since 20.07.2023; that the matter has since been compromised amongst the parties vide Annexure P-2, which is affidavit of the complainant.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Anmol Singh Sandhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Power of attorney has been filed on behalf of the complainant-Balbir Singh by Mr. Rohit, Adocate.

5. Learned counsel for the complainant has conceded the factum of compromise.

6. It is informed by learned counsel for the parties that quashing petition bearing No.6307-2024 has already been filed by the petitioner, in which parties are directed to appear before the Trial Court concerned to get their statements recorded with regard to the compromise.

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7. Having regard to the aforesaid factual position, but without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the petitioner is admitted to bail. He is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, on usual terms and conditions.
