HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner intends to approach the department for the redressal of her grievance by filing appropriate representation, which may be decided in a time bound manner.

2. Learned State counsel submits that any representation received at the hands of the petitioner, will be decided in accordance with law, keeping in view the Provident Fund Rules, within a period of 08 weeks from the receipt of any such representation and appropriate order will be passed.

3. Learned counsel appearing for respondents No.4 and 5 submits that they may also be given an opportunity of hearing before deciding any representation at the hands of the petitioner so that no prejudice be caused to them and they can file appropriate objection to the claim of the petitioner.

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4. Merely the filing of the representation would not preclude the department from releasing the benefit as per the entitlement keeping in view Rules governing the said aspect.

5. Keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.
