- 1 Through the instant petition, as instituted under Section 438 of the Cr.P.C., the petitioner has sought the concession of anticipatory bail, in case FIR No.375, dated 18.09.2023, under Section 21 of the NDPS Act, 1985, (Section 29 of the NDPS Act added subsequently).
2. Learned State counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of PPS, DSP (City), Forezepur on behalf of the respondent-State in the Court today which is taken on record.
3. A perusal of the reply reveals that the petitioner is also involved in one more case of the NDPS Act i.e. FIR No.261 dated 28.08.2019 under Sections 21/61/85 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Tarn Taran. Recovery of 273 grams of Heroin, was effected from the co-accused Sukhdev Singh, which was purchased by the co-accused Sukhdev Singh from the petitioner, that falls within the ambit of commercial quantity.
4. Considering the antecedents of the present petitioner that he is involved in one more case of NDPS Act, this court is not inclined to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
5. The instant petition is ordered to be dismissed.
