The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant anticipatory bail to them in case FIR No.0111 dated 28.12.2023, registered under Sections 323, 324, 427, 506, 148, 149, 381 of IPC (Sections 201, 326 IPC added later on), at Police Station Division No.1, Ludhiana.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the order dated 01.02.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the State has submitted that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no longer required for further investigation.
4. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the parties, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 01.02.2024, passed by this Court is made absolute. The petitioners shall continue to join investigation, as and when called by the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
