The prayer in the petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of Writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing the respondent nos.2 & 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondent nos.4 & 5 and for not harassing the petitioners on any false criminal complaint, if lodged by respondent no.4 (father of the petitioner no.2) or any of their relatives.

The Counsel for the State while referring to the reply dated 02.03.2024/05.03.2024 of Mr. Sukhwinder Pal Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Dinanagar, Gurdaspur submits that the statements of the petitioners have been recorded as per which they do not require any security.
