JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through the instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 22.01.2024 (Annexure P-4) whereby petitioner has been transferred from District Hoshiarpur to District Amritsar.
2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is going to turn 55 years on 31.07.2024 and he does not want to remain in service thereafter. He is going to seek voluntary retirement, thus, he may not be transferred.
3. Notice of Motion.
4. Mr. Inderpreet Singh Kang, AAG, Punjab, who on advance notice is present in Court, accepts notice and waives service. He submits that application of the petitioner seeking voluntary retirement till date has not been received in the office and if petitioner files application seeking voluntary retirement, his case of transfer would be reconsidered.

5. In the wake of statement of learned State Counsel, the petition stands disposed of with liberty to petitioner to move application seeking voluntary retirement and on doing so, the respondent would reconsider transfer of the petitioner from District Hoshiarpur to District Amritsar.

6. Disposed of accordingly.
