**RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)**

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 25.07.2023 passed in CWP-28098-2018.
2. Short reply by way of affidavit of respondent No.1, filed in the Registry, is taken on record.
3. Short reply by way of affidavit of Mahavir Kaushik, Deputy Commissioner, Bhiwani, filed in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
4. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 25.07.2023 passed in CWP-28098-2018 has since been complied with and necessary benefits have been granted to the petitioner, as would decipher from Annexures R-1 and R-2.
5. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
6. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
7. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
