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1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 02.02.2016 read with order dated 17.02.2017 passed in Arbitration Case Nos.229 to 232 of 2015.

2. It is not in dispute that the petitioner himself had not adhered to the schedule of payments fixed by the Court. Therefore, in terms of the orders of the Court, rights of the petitioner stood forfeited. Hence, this



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Court is not required to interfere in the matter at all.

- 3. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
- 4. However, if there is any surviving grievance of the petitioner, he would be at liberty to raise the same, but in accordance with law.
- 5. Pending application, if any, shall stand disposed of.
