This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11/12 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for not complying with the judgment dated 28.03.2023 passed by this Court in CWP-6546-2023.

Short replies by way of affidavit of respondent No.1 and 2 have been filed by learned counsel for the respondents today in the Court. The same are taken on record. Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that the order dated 28.03.2023 passed in CWP-6546-2023 has been complied with and speaking order dated 17.02.2024 has been passed.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners does not dispute the same.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

However, if any grievance of the petitioners is left unaddressed, they would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
