VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 24.05.1995 (Annexure P-5).

2. Learned counsel appearing for respondents No.2 to 5 has submitted that the petitioner has not impleaded all the affected/necessary parties and thus, the present writ petition deserves to be dismissed on account of non-joinder. It is further submitted that at any rate, the present writ petition is of the year 1996 and in all probabilities nothing survives in the same.

3. None has appeared on behalf of the petitioner to rebut the said fact.

4. In view of the above-said facts and circumstances, the present writ petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
5. Liberty is granted to the petitioner to move an application for restoration of the present petition or to file a fresh petition in case any cause survives.
