The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.0162 dated 22.11.2023 registered under Sections 21(b) and later on added Section 29 of the NDPS Act, 1985 registered at P.S. Meharban, Ludhiana.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 02.02.2024 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel has filed an affidavit of Mr. Sandeep Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police (East), Ludhiana on behalf of the State, which is taken on record and on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 02.02.2024 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 02.02.2024 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
