The prayer in the petition under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.185 dated 14.10.2023 under Sections 21 of the NDPS Act (Section 29 NDPS Act added later on) registered at P.S. Sadar, District Ferozepur.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 01.02.2024 **passed** by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State Counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 01.02.2024 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 01.02.2024 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation

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as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
