1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 02.03.2023 passed in CWP-14557-2021.

Counsel for respondent No.2 submits that the order dated 02.03.2023 passed in CWP-14557-2021 has since been complied with and legal notice of the petitioner has been decided by passing the speaking order. Copy of the speaking order, produced by the counsel for respondent No.2 in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
