1. The present petition has been filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents for wilfully and deliberate disobeyed the order dated 17.11.2023 passed by this Court in CWP 25932-2023.
2. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order qua which the contempt is asserted, has since been complied with and, therefore, the present petition may be dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
3. Counsel for the petitioner has not disputed the factual position.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
