1. Present petition has been filed for the extension of the interim bail granted to the petitioner on medical grounds.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on 19.07.2023, the petitioner was granted interim bail for a period of three months keeping in view his health condition and even as of now, the medical condition of the petitioner remains the same as he is bed ridden.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that in paragraph 3 of the reply filed, it has been mentioned that as per the report of the doctor of the Govt. Rajindera Hospital, Patiala dated 09.03.2024, the petitioner is bed ridden and is on urinary catheter support and parenteral nutrition through the nasogastric tube and needs extensive nursing care and physiotherapy.

4. Keeping in view the factual statement recorded hereinbefore,

the bail granted to the petitioner is extended upto 30.09.2024.
5. The present petition is disposed of in above terms.
